Sponsored Project - project conducted by employee(s) of Tarleton that is at least partially supported by external funds awarded to the university.

	Grant Proposal	Negotiated contract
Procure Funds	Often through RFP	Identified with sponsor typically independent from an RFP
Route for University Approvals	Using the Maestro software package, proposal is routed for university approvals.	Using the Maestro software package, project plan and contract are routed for university approvals.
Agreement/Contract	<p>If a competitive grant is awarded, an agreement for the work must be negotiated and signed by university officials.
